# JOANN CONDINO

THREE PINES STUDIO Cross Village, Michigan

#### ARTIST STATEMENT

Joann Condino's recent work involves mixed media assemblages emphasizing mark making using fiber, metal, wood. A Shibori fiber artist, Joann uses wood pieces as mark makers to create the designs on her fabrics. The wood, the mark makers, then become the marks in her assemblages. These wood and fiber pieces are about doors and the mystery behind closed doors. Additional assemblages in found metal pieces and silk reflect Joann's feelings about current social and political events.

Joann Condino's studio is a square room surrounded on three sides with windows that look out to a wrap-around porch. The windows



are trimmed in the same cedar wood as the porch roof. "It makes me feel as if the out-of-doors is part of my studio," says Joann. The studio has a collection of antique wood blocks and batik tjaps that Joann uses in her work. She also loves to be surrounded by wool yarn that she has dyed. Many skeins are indigo or dyed walnut from a Cross Village black walnut tree. Joann enjoys being alone in the studio either very early in the morning or at dusk. "I love the light of day coming and the light of the remains of the day." She loves to work facing the windows so she can catch glimpses of the birds flitting on her porch from feeder to feeder. She says of her work: "Pattern, texture and color are the language of the fiber artist. By using the techniques of monotype, printing, Shibori, hand painting and fiber-dyeing, I am exploring how art communicates a message in my assemblages."
